- High school seniors who plan to attend CLTCC (first-time students) *Must be seniors graduating in May or spring 2023*
- Students who earned their High School Equivalency Diploma or GED
- Current or continuing students (already attending CLTCC)
- Students pursuing a Career & Technical Education
- Students with a minimum 2.5 GPA, 45 HiSET, or 450 GED score
- Students who complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for the 2023-2024 award year
Must provide proof of completed FAFSA
- Students who are U.S. Citizens
